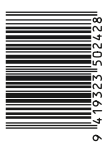

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Single Feed Bait Stations
DOUBLE TAP® Pellet Bait is a single feed possum and rat bait. Baits must only be used in covered bait stations which are placed in the ground and are accessible to possums and rats. Bait stations must be placed at least 200mm below 200mm must restrict accessibility to children and all possum bait stations must be located 200mm above the ground.

Pre-feeding

Pre-feeding is not required

NOTIFICATIONS

For Professional Users notice must be given to the occupiers & as far as practicable owners of land dwellings or buildings within the vicinity of the bait station site of the proposed application of the bait.

For Use in Bush & Forest Environments

DOUBLE TAP® Pellet Bait is a single-feed possum and rat bait and it is recommended to place between 500g – 1kg of bait in each bait station. Bait should be checked and replenished where necessary in bait stations after 6 to 10 days and bait stations left in place for about two and half months to manage the control of all resident and immigrant possums and rats.

Instructions concerning bait station loading, spacing, checking & replenishment

For use in bush and forest environments, bait stations should be placed in a grid pattern, with bait stations spaced to the local conditions of the site and the operational plan. Factors to consider & evaluate when applying these guidelines include: weather conditions, pest density, bait station accessibility, replenishment (if any) & topography of the land. Replenishments should continue until bait take stops.

If the operation is targeting possums & rats, the guidelines applications to rats should form the basis of the operational plan.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING

Early symptoms are loss of appetite, lethargy, dehydration and headache. This is followed by muscle weakness, constipation and haemorrhage.

FIRST AID:

STORAGE:

Bait should be stored in a cool dry secure place away from feed or foodstuffs. Keep containers closed when not in use. Keep out of reach of children and domestic animals. Any product held after the expiry date shown on the container should be disposed of according to the label directions.

SPLASH:

In the event of a spill, isolate the spill area and take all practical steps to manage any harmful effects. Scoop up spilled bait into secure containers. Unmanaged bait may be re-used.

Do not use the product in areas where it may be used for any other purpose. Dispose of containers to suitable landfill.

LEGAL OBLIGATIONS:

The product must only be used as specified on this label and according to the controls of the HSNQ approval. It is a legal requirement that signs must be posted to notify the public that this product has been applied in the area.
