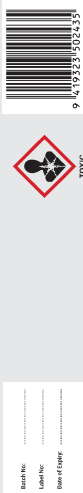

For New Zealand Forest Environments
Double Tap® Pellet Bait is a single-feed possum and rat bait and it is recommended to place between 500g – 1 kg of bait in each bait station. Bait should be checked and replenished where necessary in bait stations after 6 to 10 days and bait stations left in place for about two and half months to manage the control of all resident and immigrant possum and rat.

Bait must only be used in covered bait stations which restrict accessibility to non-target terrestrial vertebrates & which prevent weathering of the bait. Bait stations located below 200mm must restrict accessibility to children and all possum bait stations must be located 200mm above the ground.
